

NOTE: Read through all instructions before beginning installation.

Removal


- 1. Remove O2 sensor from the stock header.
- Remove left and right muffler chassis mount bolt.
- While securely supporting the muffler, remove the header nuts and carefully remove the stock muffler/header assembly.
- 4. Remove the left side muffler damper and collar from the chassis mount as it will not be used with the Yoshimura exhaust system.

Note: Remove only the left side muffler damper and collar. Right side muffler damper and collar will be re-used with the Yoshimura exhaust system.


Installation

1. Install (No. 4) 13980-MBRKT, muffler mount bracket onto frame using (No. 6) M8X35H, bolt and (No. 8) 8MMNUT, nut as shown. Do not torque at this time.


Note: The muffler mount bracket mounts to the backside of the frame as shown below.



 Remove the two right-rear oil pan bolts and install (No. 10) 13990-TPBKT, tailpipe bracket using the stock oil pan bolts. See assembly diagram for proper orientation of the tailpipe bracket. Torque oil pan bolts to 10 Nm (1.0 kg-m, 7.2 ft-lb).



3. Install *HT SHLDR77*, muffler clamp heat insulator onto (No. 3) *YM7M-MPCAX*, muffler clamp.




4. Install (No. 1) *13980-401*, Y-Series header using the stock header nuts. Do not torque at this time.

Note: The stock exhaust pipe gaskets will be reused with the Yoshimura exhaust system. Inspect and replace if necessary.

- 5. Align header bracket to (No. 10) 13990-TPBKT, tailpipe bracket and secure using (No. 7) M8X20H, bolt and (No. 8) 8MMNUT, nut as shown on the assembly diagram. Do not torque at this time.
- 6. Slide (No. 3) YM7M-MPCAX, muffler clamp over (No. 2) muffler.

7. Install (No.2) *muffler*, onto (No. 1) *13980-401*, header outlet. Align (No. 3) *YM7M-MPCAX*, muffler clamp to (No. 4) *13980-MBRKT*, and secure using (No. 5) *M10X25H*, 10mm bolt, (No. 12) *7X25SPC*, aluminum spacer, and (No. 9) *10MMFNUT*, 10mm flange nut. Do not torque at this time.



- 8. Install (No. 6) RACE-SPX-1, small exhaust springs between muffler to header connection.
- 9. Torque (No. 6) *M8X35H*, muffler mount bracket bolts to 20 Nm (2.0 kg-m, 14 ft-lb).
- 10. Torque (No. 5) *M10X25H*, muffler mount bolt to 20 Nm (2.0 kg-m, 14 ft-lb).
- 11. Torque (No. 7) *M8X20H*, header chassis mount bolt to 20 Nm (2.0 kg-m, 14 ft-lb).
- 12. Torque header nuts to 20 Nm (2.0 kg-m, 14 ft-lb).
- 13. Re-install the stock O2 sensor into (No. 1) 13980-401, Yoshimura header.
- 14. Before starting vehicle, check for proper clearance between new exhaust system and rear suspension (i.e. tire, swingarm, brakes, rear shock, and etc.) If any problem is found, please carefully follow through the installation steps again. If problem still persists, please call Yoshimura Tech Department at (800) 634-9166 / in CA (909) 628-4722.
- 15. It is recommended that the muffler and tailpipe be wiped down with rubbing alcohol to remove oil and fingerprints. This will help prevent tarnishing of the finish after the exhaust is heated up.

Note: After starting vehicle, it is normal for new exhaust system and muffler to emit smoke until oil residue burns off.

Works Finish Care & Maintenance

Before starting vehicle, clean pipe thoroughly using a soft cloth and rubbing alcohol to remove any oil and finger prints.

The color of the exhaust will change once the system has gone through a heat cycle of 15 minutes or more. Color will vary depending on lean/rich conditions.

Clean using a soft cloth and soap. Do not use abrasive materials as it will scratch the surface.

Surface reconditioning services are available to remove scratches and undesirable discoloration due to extreme heat. Contact Yoshimura Tech Department at (800) 634-9166 / in CA (909) 628-4722 for more information.

NOISE EMISSION WARRANTY

Yoshimura warrants that this exhaust system, at time of sale, meets all applicable U.S. E.P.A. Federal noise standards. This warranty extends to the first person who buys this exhaust system for purposes other than resale, and to all subsequent buyers. TAMPERING PROHIBITION

Federal law prohibits any modification to this exhaust system which causes the motorcycle to exceed the Federal noise standard. Use of the motorcycle with such a modified exhaust system is also prohibited.

Acts likely to constitute tampering include removal or puncturing the muffler, baffles, header pipes, or any other component which conducts exhaust gases.

WARNING: This product should be checked for repair or replacement if the motorcycle noise has increased significantly through use. Otherwise, the owner may become subject to penalties under state and local ordinances.

Yoshimura Catalyzed Slip-on Exhaust System Limited Warranty

WARRANTY PERIOD FOR CATALYZED EXHAUST SYSTEMS

Yoshimura R&D of America, Inc warrants this catalyzed exhaust system to the original purchase to be free from manufacturing defects for the warranted period as specified below:

- 1) If the vehicle is within 4 years of its original new purchase date, the warranty period extends for 30,000km (18,641mi) or five (5) years from the date of installation, whichever occurs first.
- 2) If the vehicle is older than 4 years from its original new purchase date, the warranty period extends for 15,000km (9,375mi) or three (3) years from the date of installation, whichever occurs first.

Postage paid product registration is included with this kit. Registration MUST be completed within 30 days of product installation. WARRANTY IS VOID IF NO PRODUCT REGISTRATION IS ON FILE AT TIME OF CLAIM.

WARRANTY VOID UPON

- 1) Abuse, misuse, improper installation, and/or modifications included, but not limited to:
 - a. the use of race fuel and/or fuel additives
 - b. leaded fuel
 - c. altered fuel injection or ignition systems
 - d. Other alterations or modifications which affect exhaust emissions

NOTE: The Yoshimura R&D Catalyzed Exhaust System includes a 3-way catalytic converter. The catalytic converter is susceptible to damage from substances including but not limited to lead, manganese, silicon, etc.

- 2) Missing proof of purchase at time of warranty claim. Original purchase must provide proof of purchase (original receipt or invoice) and a warranty authorization number (RMA) issued by Yoshimura R&D.
- 3) Finishes such as plating, painted surfaces with discoloration, or rust due to inclement weather conditions, exposure to salt or chemicals, or lack of maintenance by the customer are not covered.

Extent of Warranty

- 1) Yoshimura R&D of America, Inc hereby warrants to the initial and each subsequent purchaser of this exhaust system that said exhaust system is designed and manufactured to comply with applicable California Air Resources Board requirements and is free from defects in materials and workmanship which might cause the part to fail to conform with applicable California Air Resources Board requirements or cause damage to any original part on the highway motorcycle.
- 2) Yoshimura R&D of America, Inc will repair or replace any defective exhaust system or component caused by manufacturing defects. Any system returned to be inspected for defects MUST have a Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) which can be issued by our returns department. Yoshimura R&D recommends installation by qualified mechanics only.
- 3) Yoshimura is not responsible for any other expense incurred by the customer under the terms of this limited warranty, nor is Yoshimura responsible for damages either consequential, incidental, special, contingent or otherwise; or expenses or injury arising directly or indirectly from the use of the exhaust system.
- 4) Any exhaust system returned to Yoshimura must be sent at the customer's expense along with the proof of purchase and RMA.
- 5) Yoshimura reserves the right to determine whether the terms of the warranty, as stated above, have been properly followed. In the event that the terms are not followed, this warranty is void. Yoshimura makes the determination of abuse, misuse, installation errors and modifications—the warranty is void upon any of these conditions. The duration of any and all implied warranties are limited to the duration of the express warranty. All incidental or consequential damages are hereby excluded. The warranty gives the customer specific legal rights and the customer may have other rights which may vary from state to state. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages or limitations on the period of implied warranty. Please contact your local attorney to determine if these conditions apply.

If you have a fitment problem, missing parts, or other issues, please double-check this trouble shooting guide first:

- 1) Reference the instruction manual and double check all drawings and procedures.
- 2) Make sure ALL components are installed properly. Also verify part numbers on headers, tailpipes, and other components.
